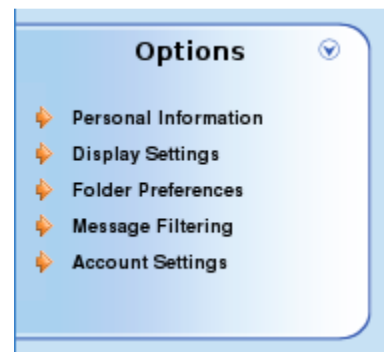


Spam Filter Setup For Hutman Webmail

To use the Spam Filtering options in the webmail, first log in to the webmail using your web browser and then select the "Account Settings" link on the left side of your browser window.



The Anti-Virus and Spam settings option panel lets you control the spam filtering and actions when the system tags email as possible spam.

No action SPAM:

No action will be taken when mail is tagged as spam.

Move SPAM:

This option Moves spam to a junk folder in your webmail

Note: When using this option, you should check the junk folder for emails which may have been wrongly tagged as spam occasionally. Mail older than 30 days will be deleted from this folder by the system.

Delete SPAM:

We do not recommend using this option as you will possibly loose email which may be wrongly classified as spam by the mail server as it will automatically delete the email which was incorrectly classified as being spam. This option will delete email tagged as spam by the mail server. If you decide to use this option, please be aware of the risks involved with possible loss of non-spam emails.

Rewrite SPAM Subject:

This option changes the subject line to include the [spam] tag for identification of possible spam items. This will make it easy to see the messages which the mail server tagged as spam and allow you to sort based on this changed subject in both the webmail and when your email program downloads your email from the mail server.

The "Anti-Spam tag score" is the spam score at which subject re-writing will take place (but no action will be taken - i.e. moving or deleting of tagged messages will not occur when the score is at or below this threshold).

The "Anti-Spam action score" is the spam score at which the "Actions" options will take place. The messages tagged with a score at or above this number will be processed by the actions chosen i.e. move to the junk folder or deleted.

Move SPAM:	<input checked="" type="radio"/> move all SPAM to the Junk folder
Delete SPAM:	<input type="radio"/> delete all SPAM without warning (danger!)
